There are two areas being applied for;

- 1) Fiordland - where the vessel currently has an Environment Southland Commercial Surface Water Consent to operate in Fiordland; from Yates Point in the north through to Puysegur Point in the south
- 2) Stewart Island – entire coastline.

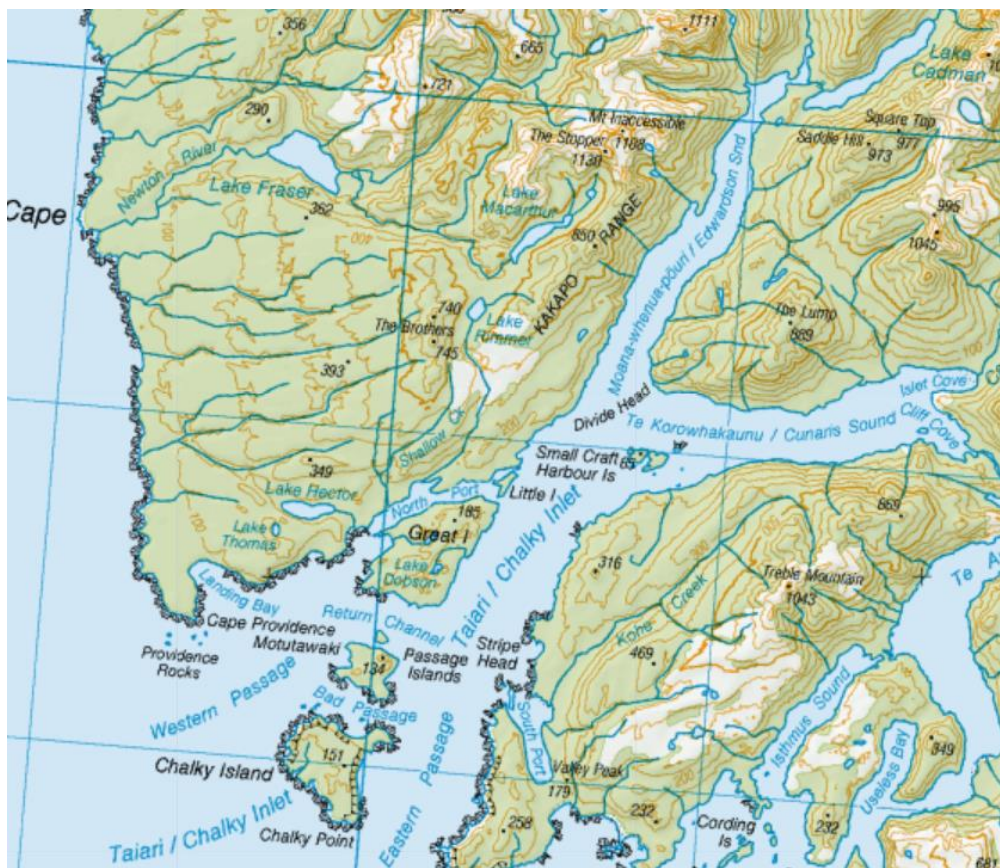


The *Heritage Explorer* and its ancillary craft operate within the internal and external waters of each of the below harbours, inlets, fiords or sounds.
